

## DART LEAGUE RULES

- 1 Number of teams and number of players on each team will be determined by the total number of players who signed up. ( number of weeks, blind weeks, and number of games and games played will be discussed at the pre-season meeting )
- 2 No husbands and wives on the same team.
- 3 Everyone must shoot two partner games and Ohio Cricket - total of three games. If you show up late you still must shoot two partner games and Ohio Cricket. If a player comes in late and there is only one partner game and Ohio Cricket left, the Captains will have to decide what to agree on as far as that player shooting.
- 4 Fees will be \$3 per week.
- 5 Both team captains must sign both tally sheets.
- 6 If both team Captains agree, after 20 minutes one cork shot by each participating player of that game, or a coin flip can determine the winning team of that game.
- 7 If there is only one player that shows up on a team, on partner games, the player shoots, then both of the other team players shoot, then the player shoots, then both of the other team players shoot, until the game is over. On the Ohio Cricket game, the player shoots, then the whole other team shoots, then the player shoots, then the whole other team shoots, until the game is over.
- 8 If no players for a team are there at starting time, after 10 minutes they forfeit the first game, and after the second ten minutes they forfeit the second game, and so forth.
- 9 On the Ohio Cricket game, each player missing from a team will be a "blind" player and score nothing for their turn.
- 10 If 3 or more players are in attendance, no one player can throw all of the games. Games should be split as evenly as possible.
- 11 If someone gets sick after one game, the Captains and Commissioners decide what to do.
- 12 No coaching on the Foul Line. Coaching on the carpet area only. Only 2 players are allowed at the scoreboard at a time. No observers or players while watching are allowed beyond the foul line.

- 13 Darts must be left in the board until your score is written on the board. If you remove your darts before marking your score on the board, you will receive one warning from the opposing team members. If this persists a second time, you will not receive any points/marks on that throw. A dart must remain in the board for a total of 5 seconds to count.
- 14 If no notice or reason for absence is given for missing the first three weeks of the dart season, you will be dropped from the dart league. During the season, if you will be unable to throw on any given Monday night due to vacation, work, illness, or other commitment, please call your team captain, the Elk's Lodge, or the Dart Commissioners and make them aware that you will not be playing.
- 15 No refunds will be made for the Banquet.
- 16 Order for the blind draws for the teams will be determined by past performance records kept by the Commissioners in order to even out the teams skill levels.
- 17 It is up to the shooter if he wants to go up to the board to see where the shot went or tell a team mate to do it.
- 18 A team must play all of their players in the first 3 partner games in the last knockdown week.
- 19 Any changes to the rules, or new rules, will be brought up and voted on at the pre-season meetings or at captains meetings during the season. All decisions by the Commissioners are final.
